

## Directions to NaCoMe



Often GPS units and directional apps will choose more difficult routes to NaCoMe. We suggest using the following directions to avoid the single lane dirt roads surrounding NaCoMe. Please notify a member of our staff if your group will be bringing a bus to camp so we can assist the driver in getting around camp.

### *From the Westside of Nashville (Approx. 1 ½ hours)*

Take I-40 West to exit 172. Turn left off the exit ramp on to Hwy 46. In 6.5 miles turn right at the traffic light onto Hwy 100. Continue on Hwy 100 through the downtown Centerville square (approximately 18 miles). After another 12 miles you will see a green sign reading "NaCoMe ¼ mile", then a large NaCoMe sign on the left side of the road. Turn right at the large sign onto NaCoMe Road. Follow 2 miles until you get into camp. The Camp Office will be on the left with the entrance to the office just after the concrete bridge. The main camp entrance is the next right at a wooden NaCoMe sign. Turn right and go across the yellow bridge to get to the main camp area.

### *From the East*

I -40 West through Nashville, towards Memphis, follow directions "From the Westside of Nashville."

### *From North of Nashville*

Take I-65 South or I-24 East to Nashville. Get on I-40 West. Continue by following the directions in the "From the Westside of Nashville" section.

### *From Chattanooga (Approx. 3hrs)*

I-24 West to I-840 west towards Dickson to Exit 7 (Centerville, Fairview, Hwy 100). Turn left onto Hwy 100 off the exit ramp towards Centerville for 24 miles to the Centerville square. Follow Hwy 100 through the square for 12 more miles. You will see a green sign reading "NaCoMe ¼ mile", then a large NaCoMe sign on the left side of the road. Turn right at the large sign onto NaCoMe Road. Follow 2 miles until you get into camp. The Camp Office will be on the left with the entrance to the office just after the concrete bridge. The main camp entrance is the next right at a wooden NaCoMe sign. Turn right and go across the yellow bridge to get to the main camp area.

### *From the South (Huntsville, AL – Approx. 2 ½ hrs)*

Take I-65 North for approximately 63 miles to Exit 37 (TN-50 - Columbia/Lewisburg). Turn left towards Columbia onto TN-50. In 13.5 miles, turn left onto Hampshire Pike. After 1 mile, turn slight right onto TN-50. Follow TN-50 for approximately 26 miles. Hwy 50 runs into Hwy 100. Turn left at the stop sign just outside of Centerville. Continue on Hwy 100 for 11 miles. You will see a green sign reading "NaCoMe ¼ mile", then a large NaCoMe sign on the left side of the road. Turn right at the large sign onto NaCoMe Road. Follow 2 miles until you get into camp. The Camp Office will be on the left with the entrance to the office just after the concrete bridge. The main camp entrance is the next right at a wooden NaCoMe sign. Turn right and go across the yellow bridge to get to the main camp area.

### *From the West (Memphis – Approx. 3 hrs)*

Take I-40 East to exit 143. Take a right off of the exit ramp, and follow Hwy 13 to the four way stop in Linden. Turn left onto Hwy 412/100. When the two highways split, continue to follow Hwy 100. In approximately 18 miles you will see a green sign on the right that says "NaCoMe 1/10 mile", then you will see a large NaCoMe sign. Turn left at the large sign onto NaCoMe Road, and follow 2 miles until you get into camp. The Camp Office will be on the left with the entrance to the office just after the concrete bridge. The main camp entrance is the next right at a wooden NaCoMe sign. Turn right and go across the yellow bridge to get to the main camp area.
